Η ΓΙΟΡΤΗ ΤΩΝ 3 ΙΕΡΑΡΧΩΝ ΣΤΟ ΣΧΟΛΕΙΟ ΜΑΣ

Στις 28 Ιανουαρίου γιορτάσαμε στο σχολείο μας τα ελληνικά γράμματα. Μια γιορτή που γιορτάζουμε κάθε χρόνο τιμώντας τους τρεις Ιεράρχες, τις σημαντικότερες ίσως μορφές της χριστιανικής ορθόδοξης γραμματείας, τους τρεις πατέρες της Εκκλησίας μας, τον Μέγα Βασίλειο, τον Γρηγόριο τον Θεολόγο και τον Ιωάννη τον Χρυσόστομο.

Την ίδια ώρα, τιμήσαμε μαζί και τους εκπαιδευτικούς μας, εν ενεργεία και μη, ως ελάχιστη εκτίμηση για τους ανθρώπους αυτούς που έθεσαν σκοπό της ζωής τους τη μετάδοση της γνώσης και την καλλιέργεια των νέων ανθρώπων στη βάση ακατάλυτων και ευγενών αξιών. Παράλληλα, η εορτή αυτή δήλωσε επίσης όχι μόνο την έφεση που έχει ο λαός, το έθνος μας στα γράμματα, αλλά και την αναγνώριση του θεμελειακού ρόλου που παίζει η παιδεία στην ιστορική διαδρομή και την προκοπή μας.

Γιορτάσαμε τα Γράμματα μαζί με την εορτή των τριών Ιεραρχών. Γιατί οι τρεις αυτές ξεχωριστές πνευματικές μορφές της Ορθοδοξίας εμπέδωσαν τη σύνθεση του οικουμενικού ελληνικού πνεύματος με το πανανθρώπινο κήρυγμα του χριστιανισμού. Οι τρεις Ιεράρχες που έζησαν και έδρασαν τον 4ο αιώνα στον Πόντο, την Καππαδοκία και την Αντιόχεια, διακρίθηκαν κατ΄ αρχήν για τη μοναδική ελληνική παιδεία τους. Δεν δίσταζε ο Μέγας Βασίλειος να δηλώνει με τη γνωστή ομιλία του «Προς τους νέους όπως αν εξ ελληνικών ωφελούντο λόγων». «Πώς να ωφελούνται δηλαδή από τα ελληνικά γράμματα.»

40 YEAR BIRTHDAY ANNIVERSARY OF THE GREEK SCHOOL OF AYIA TRIADA BIRMINGHAM

The Holy Trinity School of Birmingham is celebrating its fortieth anniversary this year. By 1981 it was fully operational with six branches in Telford, Cannock, Worcester, Tamworth, Stourbridge and Erdington. It is the largest school outside of London and currently operates with approximately 270 children in the Greek and Cypriot Home in Birmingham. Pioneers of the founding of the school of the Holy Trinity George Giakoumis, Grigoris Zachariou, Makis Papakostas, Kostas Petrouis, Ourania Christofi, Lenia Stylianou, Kyriakos Akantiotis Katerina Iordanous and there is a special place in the heart and soul of the community for their contribution and work and also their continuous struggle to ensure the operation of the school.

The school started with very little resources but great enthusiasm and love for our education, our country, our culture, our customs and traditions and one really cannot help but be moved by all that they have achieved, the school's rise and countless distinctions in Cyprus, Greece, Great Britain and abroad. Agia's school is the only school actively involved in Commonwealth affairs with many awards in the institution and the only school to ever take part in Commonwealth Day which takes place in London every March at Westminster Abbey. The event for the 40 years of operation of the school, on the occasion of the celebration of letters, was attended by the Minister of Education Dr. Athena Michailidou, the Consul General of Cyprus Mr. Odysseas Odysseos, the Consul General of Greece Mr. Alexandros Ionnidis, the Director of European Programs Dr. Ioannis Savvidis and EDE Dr. Georgia Passiardi and the Honorary Consuls of Cyprus and Greece in Birmingham Mr. Costas Petrouis and Dr. Nikolas Batis. In addition, the Director of KEA Mrs. Maria Loi and the Director of the Education Office at the Greek Embassy Mrs. Irini Veroni attended the event.

As part of the event, Dr. Michailidou addressed a festive greeting thus opening the event. Among other things she stated: "The Greek School of Ayia Triada Birmingham is one of the largest and and most important centres of expatriate Hellenism in the United Kingdom, and especially of diaspora education. With its creation in 1984, the school was staffed with experienced teachers from the Cyprus Educational Mission and together with the on-site staff and the organized parents of the communities, work every day with dedication with the aim of transmitting and promoting Greek education and education to the children of the emigrants us. The primary goal is the learning and use of the language, highlighting its value in shaping the world spirit, as well as the knowledge of elements of our history, our Greek Orthodox religion and our culture. The series of diverse actions that the school undertakes, as well as the multitude of distinctions and awards it received in competitions of UNESCO, the Ministry of Education, Sports and Youth and other organizations in Cyprus and Greece, confirm its special commitment and activity in matters concerning, among others, the promotion of our cultural heritage, peace and environmental protection. It is worth noting, as indicative of his influential action, the representation of the school, the children and their teacher, for the first time, at Commonwealth events and at Buckingham Palace." Our Minister also emphasized that the school's upward trajectory is primarily due to the voluntary contribution and hard work of all the members of this community, who for 40 years now with a spirit of collegiality and patriotism,







DANCE CLASSES




This year our school has been running dance classes led by our Dance Teachers Mrs Sotiria Karafillides and Mr Dimitris Themistokleous.

THEOPHANY JANUARY 6TH

At the Greek Orthodox Church of Holy Trinity and Saint Lukes

The main ritual of Theophania in Greece involves the Great Blessing of the Waters.

On January 6th, the clergy, accompanied by a procession, go to bodies of water, such as rivers, lakes, or the sea. A cross is then thrown into the water, symbolizing the baptism of Jesus, and young people dive into the cold water to retrieve it, competing to be the first to bring it back. It is believed that the person who retrieves the cross will be blessed for the entire

The celebration of Theophania is not only a religious event but also a cultural one. In many Greek towns and villages, festivities include music, dance, and traditional food, making it a joyful occasion for communities to come together.





The 3 Hierarches



Méras Basileios

St. Basil is particularly renowned for his theological writings and for his philanthropic work. He emphasized the Christian duty to care for the less fortunate and established a complex of charitable institutions known as the "Basiliad." These included a hospital, a poorhouse, and a hospice for travelers, reflecting his commitment to social justice and compassionate care for those in need.

Article 21: Adoption and Kids If kids can't live with their own family, governments will try to find them a new family who will love and take care of them.

Article 22: Refugee Kids If you had to leave your country because it wasn't safe, the government will make sure you get special help and protection.

Article 23: Special Care for Kids with Disabilities

Kids who have disabilities have the right to special care and support to help them learn and play, just like all kids!

Article 24: Good Health for Kids Everyone wants to make sure you're healthy, so you have the right to good healthcare and

Article 25: Every child who has been placed somewhere away from home - for their care, protection or health - should have their situation checked regularly to see if everything is going well and if this is still the best place for the child to be.

Article 26: Governments should provide money or other support to help children from poor families.

Article 27: Children have the right to food, clothing and a safe place to live so they can develop in the best possible way. The government should help families and children who cannot afford this.

INTERNATIONAL HOLOCAUST REMEMBRANCE DAY

The International Holocaust Remembrance Day, or the International Day in Memory of the Victims of the Holocaust, is an international memorial day on 27 January that commemorates the victims of the Holocaust, which resulted in the genocide of one third of the Jewish people, along with countless members of other minorities by Nazi Germany between 1933 and 1945.
