Admissions Circular – Nursery & Reception Entry (Age 3.5+)

Summary on the admissions age as this was decided on a Management Board Meeting in September 2010. To ensure that every child joins us confidently and safely, the following criteria and procedures apply for all new admissions.

Admissions Age Requirement

Children may join Nursery or Reception from the age of 3.5 years old.

Readiness Criteria

To support a smooth and positive start, all children must:

1. Be fully toilet trained (able to use the toilet independently).
2. Attend one free taster lesson, arranged by the school.
3. Complete two settling-in days successfully, which allow the child to adapt to the class routine.

Settling-In Days

Following the free taster lesson, families will be offered two settling-in sessions:

- £40 per day per child – Saturday sessions
- £30 per day per child – Weekday sessions

Both sessions must be attended and completed positively before full admission is confirmed.

Purpose of Settling-In Process

This process helps us ensure that:

- Your child feels comfortable in the classroom environment.
- Teachers can assess readiness for group participation.
- Parents receive feedback and reassurance about their child's transition.

Next Steps

If you would like to register your child or book a taster session, please contact the school office. Places are offered on a first-come, first-served basis and may be limited depending on class capacity.

We look forward to welcoming your child into our school community and supporting their first steps in Greek language and culture.
